All services that Enviu provides to you are subject to the following Terms of Use. Enviu reserves the right to update the Terms of Use. In that case you will receive a notice by e-mail. The most current version of the Terms of Use can be reviewed on www.os-house.org/ and oshouse.viadesk.com

Information

Stichting Enviu, a foundation registered in the Dutch Chamber of Commerce register Rotterdam with number 24357922 (hereafter: “Enviu”) initiated the Open Source House project to contribute to sustainable building in the developing world from a social, environmental and economical perspective. Enviu hopes to this mission to encourage people to make designs of sustainable and affordable housing available to the public by sharing them online and generate impact by making use of the economic opportunities of eco-affordable building. The international design competition is the first step in this process. The goal of this competition is to generate the first sustainable and affordable design solutions for a housing project in Ghana.

Information regarding the background of the Competition, the challenge and aims, the definitive competition schedule, the design criteria, the assessment criteria, the submission criteria, the jury report, available prizes and other relevant information for the Competition will be made available the coming months, the latest at the start of the Competition.

Contributors to the Open Source House Platform are bound by these Terms of Use and the additional Competition guidelines that will be published on the Open Source House Platform, if a Contributor does not approve the application of mentioned terms it is not possible to upload Designs.

Definitions

Competition: The Open Source House Design Competition organized by Enviu. The winner of the Competition is recommended by an expert jury. The jury will be appointed at the discretion of Enviu. The competition will start mid January and will end in May or June (see www.osh-house.org for the newest updates on the planning of the competition).

Contributor: Participants in the Competition and anyone who places a Design on the Open Source House Platform.

Design: all design concepts, drawings, images, renderings, sketches, photographs, models, and/or text, documents, information or other materials submitted to the website <http://oshouse.viadesk.com/> by Contributors.

Open Source House Platform: The Open Source Platform website <http://oshouse.viadesk.com/> and especially the pages that list Designs and where users can view, upload and download Designs.

Interim information

All correspondence is conducted via the website www.os-house.org, the Open Source House Platform <https://oshouse.viadesk.com> or email: oshouse@enviu.org.

Eligibility

Participation in the Competition is open to architects and designers, visual artists, students as well as everyone who is interested in this subject. To participate in the Competition, Contributors have to supply correct contact details. Members of the jury and the Open Source House team from Enviu are excluded from participation.

Enviu has the right to, without reason, refuse Designs or the participation of a Contributor or at any time disqualify a Contributor by Enviu's sole discretion. In any case, Enviu can refuse a Design from the Open Source House Platform, especially when the Contributor acts in breach of these Terms of Use or supplied incorrect information or in any way violated the law.

Privacy

Contributors are bound by the Privacy Policy of Enviu on <http://os-house.org/english/os-house/Disclaimer> and/or <https://oshouse.viadesk.com/do/wbpage/?id=800-767762706167>. This Privacy Policy forms an integral part of these Terms of Use. By approving these Terms of Use, User also approves the purposes of collecting personal data by Enviu.

Prizes and awards

The actual realization of the Design (building) is the prize of Competition. This realization will be performed under Enviu's conditions (for example location, date) and by a third party appointed by Enviu.

Enviu could include additional reward opportunities into the Competition, which will be published before the start of the Competition. Enviu will make every reasonable effort to contact the winning Contributor and notify the Contributor of the award. In the event the winning Contributor chooses not to accept the award, or cannot be contacted for any reason, or fails to respond to notification attempts and/or emails within 14 days after first notification, any prize, whether it will be involvement into detailing and implementation or funding, will be forfeited. In such case, the winning Contributor cannot claim any prize. Enviu may, but is not obligated to, award the prize concerned to another Contributor in its sole discretion. Correspondence with Enviu on the finalist Contributions or the winner of the Competition is not possible.

No substitution or transfer of prize is permitted. Enviu reserves the right not to award (all) prizes in the event Enviu receives an insufficient number of eligible Designs that meet the minimum criteria as set forth as part of the Competition guidelines.

Publicity, publications and exhibition

Contributors are prohibited to make public any information concerning the content of the Designs as such, before Enviu has publicly announced the results. Breaches of these Terms of Use will result in disqualification from the Competition.

Without prejudice to the Ownership and Copyrights clause, Enviu reserve the rights to showcase all submitted Designs on the world wide web, as well as any other future reproduction and/or publication. The results of the Competition may be presented online, in galleries or other venues, or in a printed publication and all Designs will be available to be

viewed by users of oshouse.viadesk.com and/or www.os-house.org. The name and place of residence of the winner of the Competition will be widely communicated.

Without prejudice to the Ownership and Copyrights clause, the selection of Designs made by the jury of the Competition will feature in publicity activities to draw attention to the Competition results. Ideas under consideration include the presentation of these Designs in a publication and an exhibition to accompany the prize-giving ceremony. Further information about planned publicity activities will be announced on the above-mentioned website.

In any exhibition, publication, or website, Enviu will make every effort to properly attribute the appropriate Contributor. Enviu reserves the right to utilize materials submitted by Contributors in any publication or promotional endeavor in perpetuity and free of charge (See "Ownership and Copyrights").

Ownership and Copyrights

By entering the Competition and by placing or uploading any Design to the Open Source House website, Contributors agree to a) post Designs to the Open Source House Platform and to these Terms of Use of the Open Source House for Contributors; b) to license all materials submitted under the [Creative Commons Attribution-Share Alike 3.0](https://creativecommons.org/licenses/by-sa/3.0/) license and to adhere to the terms of that license towards Enviu and any users of the Open Source House Platform. The Creative Commons Attribution-Share Alike 3.0 license form an integral part of these Terms of Use. Please find the Creative Commons Attribution-Share Alike 3.0 license attached to these Terms of Use as Annex I.

Please note, however, that to the extent these Terms of Use of the Open Source House for Contributors conflict with the Terms of Use of the Open Source House for Users or the Creative Commons Attribution-Share Alike 3.0 license, these Terms of Use of the Open Source House for Contributors prevail.

In short, the Creative Commons Attribution-Share Alike 3.0 license means that the Contributor will remain as the author and owner of the Designs submitted in association with the Competition and the Open Source House Platform provided by Enviu. The Contributor grants perpetual, free, unrestricted and including but not limited to commercial use of the Designs. Every user of the Designs is obliged to properly attribute the author or licensor of the Designs, by mentioning its name. A user is allowed to alter, transform, or build upon the Design, but may distribute the resulting work to third parties only under the same, similar or a compatible license.

Contributors that modify a Design originating from another Contributor and upload such modified Designs are obliged to attribute the Design correctly as well, by also mentioning the name/attribution of the previous author(s) of that Design. Although Enviu endeavors that users and Contributors of the Open Source House Platform will properly attribute the used and modified Designs, it cannot guarantee that the Designs are always (correctly) attributed. Contributor indemnifies Enviu against any claims in this respect.

Contributor grants Enviu a non-exclusive, unlimited, indefinite, royalty-free license for the use of the Designs, including commercial use, the right to make adaptations and for any (future) exploitation, as well as permission to sublicense these rights, including sublicensing to its users of the Open Source House Platform under the Creative Commons Attribution-

Share Alike 3.0 license. Contributors will hereby waive all moral rights as far as possible by law.

Commercial use can be directed towards commercial advantage or private monetary compensation. This is in line with the mission of Enviu to generate environmental, social and economic impact. Notwithstanding Enviu's rights and third parties' rights on the basis of the Creative Commons Attribution-Share Alike 3.0 license following these Terms of Use, Contributors shall retain full rights to use the Designs in other projects for commercial and for-profit purposes.

No termination

The license provided in these Terms of Use by Contributors is perpetual (for the duration of the applicable copyright in the Designs). Without prejudice to Enviu's rights and third parties' rights on the basis of the Creative Commons Attribution-Share Alike 3.0 license following these Terms of Use, the Contributor has the right to release the Designs under different license terms or to stop distributing the Designs at any time. Any such election will not serve to withdraw this license, and this license will continue in full force and effect.

Warranties and liabilities

The Contributor warrants that all Designs submitted to the Open Source House Platform do not infringe upon any rights of third parties and that they have full authority to submit the materials for such purposes. Contributor indemnifies Enviu and the users of the Open Source House Platform against any claims in this respect.

Enviu - including its partners, chartered units, and its governors, directors, officers, employees, agents, funders, sponsors and volunteers- shall not be liable for any and all claims, demands, liabilities, losses, damages and costs (including costs of defence and attorney fees) of whatever kind, caused by or resulting from submitting or the use of and handling of the Designs or services it provides in connection with Open Source House Platform.

Enviu is not liable for any consequences of any computer breakdown, disruptions of the www.os-house.org website, the Platform oshouse.viadesk.com or the internet and excludes liability when the Contributor cannot participate in the Competition.

Follow-up to the competition:

The detailing and realization (building) of the (winning) Designs falls outside the scope of the competition.

Enviu reserves the right to commission additional detailing of the designs of Contributors selected as finalists which Designs are eligible for implementation. This is done to facilitate implementation by local stakeholders. Enviu will make a reasonable effort to involve the relevant Contributor in implementing and building the (winning) Design, but is not obliged to do so.

Disputes

These Terms of Use shall be governed by the laws of The Netherlands.

The jury has the sole authority and responsibility to recommend winners at the end of the Competition. Enviu reserves the right to make a final decision regarding the winning Design and any prize that may be made available in the Competition. Enviu's decisions in connection with all matters concerning the Competition shall be final and binding.

Any dispute, controversy or claim arising out of or relating to these Terms of Use, or the breach, termination or invalidity thereof, shall be settled by the competent court in Amsterdam, the Netherlands.
